BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Governor-General, and the Parliament of the State of Steamhappia, as follows:

1 Establishment of Cabinet Roles

(1) The following roles shall be created as official positions within the Steamhappia Government:

- a) Home Secretary
- b) Treasury Secretary
- c) Justice Secretary

(2) - Cabinet Secretaries shall act in the public interest and maintain the confidentiality of sensitive matters of state.

2 Home Secretary

(1) The Home Secretary shall be responsible for:

- a) Oversight of internal affairs, including public safety, civil administration, and immigration

- b) Coordinating with the National Police
- c) Advising the Government on domestic policy and internal security issues

(2) The Home Secretary shall have the following powers:

- a) May issue binding directives to the National Police
- b) May establish internal policy frameworks for civil administration and public order
- c) May recommend the deprivation of citizenship for individuals deemed a national security threat, subject to judicial review and in accordance with the law.

3 Treasury Secretary

(1) The Treasury Secretary shall be responsible for:

- a) Managing the National Treasury and advising on economic and fiscal policy
- b) Overseeing national budgets, taxation, and financial institutions
- c) Ensuring financial transparency and the stability of the national currency

(2) The Treasury Secretary shall have the following powers:

- a) May authorise government spending within the national budget
- b) May issue financial regulations to institutions under Treasury oversight
- c) May freeze or redirect public funds in emergency, subject to the Prime Minister's oversight.

4 Justice Secretary

(1) The Justice Secretary shall be responsible for:

- a) Administration of the legal and judicial system
- b) Liaising with judges and legal officers on justice policy
- c) Proposing reforms to improve fairness and efficiency in justice

(2) The Justice Secretary shall have the following powers:

- a) May propose legislation concerning criminal and civil law reform
- b) May issue legal policy guidance to the Judiciary in accordance with constitutional principles
- c) May appoint or dismiss legal advisors, subject to the Prime Minister's oversight.

5 Salaries and Budget

(1) Cabinet Secretaries shall each receive a salary of at least 20,000 weekly, paid out by the Prime Minister who can delegate this.

(2) The Prime Minister has the authority to increase or decrease the salary, provided it is not below the minimum.

6 Oversight and Reporting

- (1) Cabinet Secretaries shall be required to report on their department's activities to the Prime Minister.
- (2) All Cabinet Secretaries shall be answerable to Parliament and may be called upon to present reports or answer questions regarding their department.
- (3) All Cabinet powers shall be subject to constitutional limits and oversight by the Office of the Prime Minister.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Governor-General, and the Parliament of the State of Steamhappia, as follows:

1 Establishment of the NPS

(1) The National Police Service is established.

(2) In this act the service is referred to as the "NPS".

(3) The NPS is operated by the Government under the Office of the Home Secretary.

2 Functions of the NPS

(1) The NPS has a duty to-

- (a) protect the peace and public safety of the State.
- (b) uphold the law and the Constitution.
- (c) respect and defend the rights of the People.

(2) The NPS is an impartial agency that can be held accountable by the Courts and Parliament.

3 Officers of the NPS

(1) Officers of the NPS or "Officer(s)" are dutybound to uphold the law and follow the duties of the NPS

(2) Before being designated an Officer a person must-

- (a) be deemed fit and able to perform their duties.
- (b) have no interests that could conflict with their operations.
- (c) be a citizen of the state and clean criminal record.

(3) Officers of the NPS are appointed and removed by the Chief of Police of the NPS.

(4) Officers that are deemed unfit for duty as specified by Subsection 1 are to be dismissed from duty.

4 Chief Of Police of the NPS

(1) The Chief of Police or the "Chief" is the head of the NPS.

(2) The Chief is appointed by the Home Secretary and serves at their pleasure.

(3) In order to be appointed the Chief of police must comply with the terms set by Section 3 Subsection 1.

(4) The Chief of Police has a duty to-

- (a) appoint and remove Officers.
- (b) manage day to day operations of the NPS.
- (c) write rules and guidelines for the operations of the NPS.
- (d) manage the budget of the NPS.

5 Budget of the NPS

(1) The NPS is to receive a weekly 10,000 Steamshilling budget.

(2) The budget is to be spent on-

(a) Salaries of Officers, the Chief and other staff.

(b) Day to day operations of the agency.

(c) Crime prevention programs.

(d) Outreach, advertisement and recruitment.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Governor-General, and the Parliament of the State of Steamhappia, as follows:

The Companies House

1 The Companies House

- (1) The Companies House, an executive Government body wholly owned and controlled by the Home Office is established.
- (2) Companies house is to be an authority that oversees and documents companies in Steamhappia.
- (3) The Companies House is lead by a Chief Executive whom is appointed and serves at the leisure of the Home Secretary.
- (4) In absence of a Chief Executive the Home Secretary inherits the role.

2 Duties of the Companies House

- (1) The Companies House has the powers to:
 - (a) Create companies
 - (b) Dissolve companies

(c) Transfer companies

(d) Audit companies

(2) The Companies House must respect private property and ownership principals may only use its powers if-

(a) they are legally empowered to either through-

(i) the Law or Constitution, or

(ii) by order of a Court of the State.

(b) they are acting on the consent of the Business owner.

(3) The Companies House has a responsibility to-

(a) Ensure that citizens have a pathway of opening a private Business

(b) Act to stop business crime and/or crime committed through business

(c) Create government/public entities as required by Law or the Constitution

(d) Keep a record and/or database of all current and past companies with accompanying information.

Companies and other Corporate Bodies

3 Company Definition

(1) A Company is an entity which-

(a) Has an owner

(b) Can have executives appointed by the owner

(c) Has a pool of Steamshillings which

(i) can be deposited into, or

(ii) can be withdrawn or,

(iii) can be paid out to others.

(2) Companies can be dissolved and transferred after creation.

4 Registration of a Company

(1) In order to register a company a Citizen must apply to the Companies House with the following information:

- (a) The name of the company
- (b) A basic description of the company
- (c) An initial amount of capital they wish to deposit into the company
- (b) A list of executives they want to appoint

(2) The fee of incorporating a Company is to be set by the Chief Executive of the Companies House and may be no more than Fifty Thousand (50,000) and no less than Ten Thousand (10,000) Steam Shillings.

(3) Companies house may refuse to register should they believe the company may be used for criminal activity.

5 Transfer and Dissolution of a Company

(1) The owner of a company may request to dissolve or transfer a company to another and such should be carried out by Companies House as long as-

- (a) the company remains unfrozen
- (b) a court has not blocked it
- (c) it is not under investigation for criminal activity by the NPS
- (d) companies house reasonably believes that it is not going to be used in future criminal activity.

(2) The price of dissolving and transferring companies is to be set by the Chief Executive of Companies House and must be no more than Twenty Five Thousand (25,000) Steam Shillings.

6 Company Naming

(1) No two companies should have the same name or names that are too similar and Companies House may refuse to register on grounds of such.

(2) Companies that are registered to a private individual must contain the suffix "Co" or "Company" in their name.

(3) Companies registered under the Government must contain the suffix "Gov" in their name.
